



PRESS RELEASE OFFICERS SAVE OVERDOSE VICTIM

At approximately 5:30 pm Round Lake Park Police Officers responded to the 400 Block of Brierhill Drive for a reported overdose. Preliminary findings indicate Fentanyl was injected.

Officers were first to arrive on the scene finding a 28 year old male unconscious and not breathing. Officers immediately administered Naloxone reviving the Antioch resident. The victim refused transport to the hospital.

Chief George Filenko said;

“It’s unfortunate that the Opioid crises still continues to take lives. This was a situation that demonstrated the need to continue training and equipping our police officers to save lives. I’m proud of our officers quick decisive actions.”
