



PRESS RELEASE- Man Forces Way into House Attacks Occupant with Golf Club

On Saturday June 8, 2019 at approximately 1130 AM Richard Douglas-McDonald, 21 of the 1200 Block of Roosevelt Av, Chicago was arrested in the 400 Block of Clifton Drive after he had smashed out a window of a back door to a home, with a golf club, subsequently kicking in the door and chasing the resident with a golf club.

McDonald had been charged with battery several hours earlier at the same location and released on a personal recognizance bond.

“It appears McDonald returned to the house and teed off on the door breaking a window and the door frame then began chasing a subject in the home with 3 iron in hand”.

Charges:

- * Class 4 Felony - Criminal Damage To Property

- * Class B Misdemeanor - Criminal Trespass to Real Property

**Douglas-McDonald stated he could not post so he will be holding until pre-trial services on the 11th. Felony Criminal Damage to Property, Felony Criminal Trespass, and Obstructing a Peace Officer.

Further charges may be pending as the investigation continues.
